- Essential to pin down problems as accurately as possible




What has been done?




HEIs connected to EWP








HEIs ready to exchange IIA data HEIs ready to exchange LA data












HEIs issuing ESI





Concrete qualitative progress



- Issue of one cooperation condition per IIA has been resolved (this affected thousands of agreements and HEIs)
- 2. Number of IIA concluded over EWP increased considerably over the last 3 months
- 3. Increasing number of 3PP able to successfully exchange IIA
- 4. Also increasing numbers of concluded LAs over EWP





And concrete challenges



In spite of marked improvements regarding IIA interoperability problems still persist.

At the time of publication of this report **5 providers out of 16** do not yet meet IIA interoperability requirements.





Most affected countries







A solution in sight



- EWP team has identified key steps and solutions and shared it with providers
- Which will vastly improve IIA exchange for more than 80% of the affected HEIs (if/when they are implemented by the affected providers)





"... decisive action is needed regarding the 320 HEIs that are currently connected to EWP via providers that cannot yet ensure an adequate exchange of IIA data"





Ongoing actions



- Continued technical cooperation with concerned 3PP
- Activate EWP Relationship Managers
- Open the ESCI Service desk to interoperability tickets
- Complete technical work on collection of statistics, error logging and compliance testing

Goal until end of 2022



To ensure all HEIs connected to the EWP production network can conclude agreements without interoperability issues





Practical advice for IROs



- Assess which systems you can exchange agreements smoothly with
- 2. Prioritise the digital renewal of agreements with partners using those systems
- 3. Resort to the EWP Stats Portal for more information (if needed)



Any new EWP target only set after



- Complete set of technical specifications and mandatory business requirements are available
- A implementation threshold is reached as confirmed by robust testing by technical teams
- And a decision made after consultation with EWP governance bodies



To conclude



- There are less issues for LAs than for IIAs
- EWP works but some critical nodes do not
- Current IIA issues are mostly caused by five 3PP
- Aiming to eradicate issues by end of 2022
